North Shore Montessori School strives to serve the educational needs of children and families located in and around northern New England, by offering an exceptional Montessori education for children age thirty-two months through age twelve. Our focus in applying Montessori principles is to give each child the opportunity to be nurtured, educated and inspired at his or her own unique pace in order to optimize their personal educational experience.

North Shore Montessori School is pleased we will be going into our twelfth year anniversary coming up in the 2018-2019 school year. Our continued growth and expansion provides an education that is becoming well known throughout the local and surrounding communities. We would like to invite you to attend our school for the 2018-19 school year. North Shore Montessori School is located at 121 Wetherfield St., Rowley, MA 01969. The school is beautifully set on two acres of land far from busy traffic and street noise. We currently have one Children's House Classroom, one Lower Elementary Classroom serving grades 1 through 3, and our Upper Elementary Program for grades 3rd through 6th.

We have two all school field trips, one in the fall to Cider Hill Orchard for a hay ride, apple picking, cider donuts and corn maze; the other in March to the Ipswich/Topsfield Audubon Sanctuary for a walk in the winter, learning about maple trees and maple sugaring. Our in-house guest Lisa Hutchings from Joppa Flats comes three times a year to explore Fall, Winter and Spring in our own back yard; Eagle Bear from Colorado joins our circle telling us Native American stories and performing traditional dances one being the hoop dance. Some field-trips planned for the Elementary children will be the Peabody Essex Museum, the MFA Boston, Essex Ship Building Museum and more. The Upper Elementary students also rescued stranded turtles on Cape Cod in December 2017, once a month the upper elementary partner with the Professional Center for Child Care Development in Andover, MA and read to their students, We have partnered with Merrohawke attending some outdoor educational experiences on their site.

Tuition Payment Plans

_____ **Plan A - Annual Tuition Payment:** Payment of entire tuition, minus the tuition deposit, due by May 1, 2018. Payment may be made by check.

_____ **Plan B - Semi-Annual Tuition Payment:** 2 pre-dated and signed checks must be submitted by May 1, 2018. Checks should be dated May 1, 2018 and Nov 1, 2018.

_____ **Plan C - Quarterly Tuition Payment:** 4 payments starting May 1, 2018. Four pre-dated and signed checks must be submitted by May 1, 2018. Checks should be dated May 1, 2018, August 1, 2018, November 1, 2018 and February 1, 2019.

_____ **Plan D - Monthly Tuition Payment:** 10 monthly payments starting May 1, 2018. Ten pre-dated and signed checks must be submitted by May 1, 2018. Checks dated the first of each month from May 1, 2018 through February 1, 2019.

* **Tuition Late Payment:** A fee of \$25.00 will be charged every 10 days late.

Early-After-Care

Early-After-Care is offered at the rate of \$12.00 per hour for one child, and \$15.00 an hour for more than one child in a family, and billed in half hour increments. Early-Care is from 7:45 a.m. - 9 a.m. and After-Care is from 3 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. If earlier or later care is needed, please come see me to explore the possibilities. Invoices will be sent out at the end of each month and payment is due within a week of receiving the bill.
